Invest in Workforce Development

THE CHALLENGE: Our community boasts one of the nation's highest percentages of adults with advanced degrees and one of the lowest unemployment rates, but the current talent pipeline is broken. Local employers often struggle to find qualified workers, and many residents need better training and access to compelling career pathways.

THE GOAL: Create an employer-led talent pipeline that aligns education and training opportunities with high-demand jobs, increasing the social mobility of all residents, while also meeting the workforce needs of employers.

Accelerate Small Business Growth and Improve Business Retention and Startup Support

THE CHALLENGE:

Entrepreneurs must overcome a series of hurdles to launch and scale their enterprises locally. To make it easier to start and grow a business, we need to better organize the innovation and business support ecosystems.

THE GOAL: Establish a more cohesive system that improves business growth and retention, and focuses efforts on starting and growing Black, Latinx, and refugee owned enterprises.

Increase Housing Supply and Affordability

THE CHALLENGE: Rent for a two-bedroom has increased 29% since 2019, and 52% of Orange County renters are burdened by their housing costs. Orange County has 10,500 more jobs than housing units. We need solutions to dramatically increase housing supply and affordability.

THE GOAL: Add 600 housing units each year to keep up with existing demand, and prioritize housing affordability by adding 1,500 units of permenantly affordable housing.


